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Burlap & Floral Centerpiece

This burlap and floral centerpiece is the perfect combination of fresh and country-chic. Add it to your table as a Spring centerpiece, give it as a Mother's Day gift, or mass produce it for Wedding decor. The possibilities are endless!



Materials Checklist

- Flowers of your choice
- Large Keepsake Totes Storage Paint Can
- 6 in. Burlap Ribbon
- 2.5 in. Burlap Ribbon
- Clear Plastic Zip Ties
- Floral Shears
- Scissors
- Assorted Buttons
- Wire

Instructions:

1. Remove the label from your Keepsake Totes Storage Paint Can. Heating the sticker with an embossing gun or hair dryer for a few seconds will make it easier to peel the label off.
2. Cut a 1.5 yard strip off of the thin (2.5 in.) burlap ribbon and a 25 inch strip off of the thick (6 in.) burlap ribbon.
3. Lay your can on its side, on top of the thick burlap strip. Wrap one end of the thick burlap around the can and hold it in place. Fold the other end of the thick burlap in a few inches and wrap it over the first end. While holding the wrap in place, put the thin strip of burlap under the paint can. Use the thin burlap ribbon to tie a knot around the front of the burlap fold. Make a loop with one end of the thin burlap. Take the other end and bring it around the back of your loop. Stick this end through the middle of your loop and pull through to secure. Trim any excess burlap.
4. Arrange your flowers as you please and secure with a zip tie. Trim the centerpiece to the proper height for your can and place it inside.
5. Take your wire and add a kink about 1 inch long. Thread the wire kink through the back of your first button hole and then back through the second hole. Once the wire has been threaded through the button, grab the end of the kinked wire along side your strand of wire and twist the two together to keep the button in place. Repeat this process, adding a button every 3 to 4 inches to your wire strand.
6. Wrap your finished button wire around the center of your can twice, and twist the ends to secure it.
