

EAT Copper Penny Paper Mache Letters

These decorated paper mache letters make trendy kitchen or dining room decor. Use copper paint and pennies to create this look, or try a variation using silver paint and dimes!

Materials Checklist

- Paper Mache letters #2861-E/A/T
- Pennies
- Acrylic paint: metallic copper and burnt sienna #DADCA11-3
- Acrylic topcoat sealant
- Paintbrush
- E-6000 adhesive #EPE-6000-12C
- Paper towels

1. Mix the copper paint with a little bit of the burnt sienna paint. Paint the letters and let dry. Paint on a second coat if needed.
2. Lay the pennies out onto the letters and then glue them in place. Let glue dry overnight.
3. If desired, paint a topcoat sealer over the letters. Let dry completely.
